C. POLICIES & PROCEDURES

1. Junior Students Participating at the Intermediate Level:

- a) Students in grade six or lower may participate in athletics at the Intermediate level at the same school. However, participation in *any regular season league game* at the Intermediate level by the 'Junior' student forfeits his/her opportunity to participate in the same sport at the Junior level. (For example: If a boy in grade six plays Intermediate basketball, he is *not permitted* to play Junior basketball.)
- b) A junior team can be declared *ineligible* to play in the centrally-organized post-season tournament if *any* individual member of that team has played at the intermediate level .Before this team is declared ineligible , the situation will be reviewed by the Convenor, the Area Chairs, the Elementary Athletic Co ordinator, the Health and Physical Education Consultant and a member of the Administrative Athletic Executive.
- c) Junior teams may participate at the Area Level on an exhibition basis using Junior players who participated at the Intermediate level with approval from the rest of the schools involved in the league. They may not however advance beyond area play.
- d) There are no age level restrictions in Elementary Interschool Sports. Intermediate is deemed to be Grade 7 and 8 while Junior is deemed Grade 6 and under.
