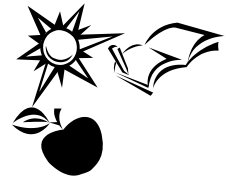

LATE REGISTRATION

Completed Summer School applications (signed by your Home School Principal) will be accepted for all new credit online courses if entered into the eLearning Registration System by your home school guidance councillor or in person at Eden Secondary School on July 4, 2011.
