Who can receive funding?

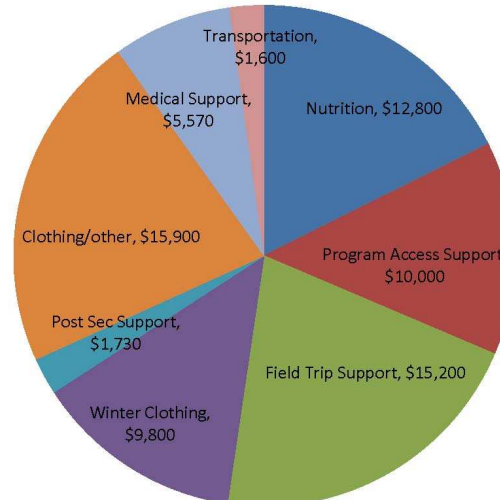
- Students who are experiencing financial constraints and who require basic personal needs.
