Sobeys Ontario Promotes Nutritional Choices

A recent grant of \$3,000 was awarded to the Education Foundation of Niagara to support public school breakfast programs in Niagara. Sobeys Ontario grants funds to support breakfast programs provincially and locally. The funding was dedicated to South Lincoln High School, St. Catharines Collegiate, Port Weller Public School in St. Catharines and Garrison Road Public School in Fort Erie. EFN has granted over \$80,000 to nutritional programs in District School Board of Niagara schools in three years, representing a small portion of the actual need that exists in Niagara. Without traditional support, schools must fundraise, apply for grants and work with community organizations to support their school community need. In addition to supporting our nutrition programs, Sobeys staff can be seen volunteering at these local schools to provide even more support to their community.
